ACTIVITIES



Padstow and its surrounding area provide visitors with a wide range of activities; there's always something to do whatever the weather.

Running along the length of the north coast of Cornwall is the South West Coastal Path with its wonderful views and walks - parts of the path are steep and hard work but there are some easy stretches as well. And away from the coast, there are walks in and around the town and surrounding countryside; you will find maps and guide books on the book shelves at Ellerys.

Interspersed between the high cliffs of the spectacular north coast are rocky coves and miles of sandy beaches; in fact there are so many that you're spoilt for choice. The website <u>www.Padstowlive.com</u> tells you about those beaches within easy distance of Padstow with details about parking, facilities and whether they are dog "friendly".
